

Letter to Our Supporters:

Hello Supporters of the Dr Martin Luther King Jr Celebration Committee of St Johns County, Inc.

After careful consideration and in an abundance of caution for the safety of all, we have decided to make substantial changes to the traditional way we will celebrate the National Holiday honoring Dr King:

1. We have entered a partnership with Flagler College, Office of Diversity and Inclusion to put on this year's event.

2. The event will be at Flagler College Auditorium with no charge for attendees who will be allowed onsite and in person. The entire event will be viewable via live

streaming and pre-recorded segments.

3. The event will be presented mostly virtual and live streamed to the public with only a portion of the program being live onsite.

4. COVID-19 restricts the number of onsite attendees, so invitations to participate/attend the event onsite will be restricted. Tickets will be offered on a first come first serve basis. Sponsors and Supporters will receive a set number of admission tickets based on each level of support. The remainder of tickets will be made available to the general public up to the total covid-19 restricted capacity in affect at that time. Tickets are available at Eventbrite:

5. Attendees onsite will receive a Brunch-To-Go Box as well as those via zoom will have the option to purchase (rsvp) a Brunch-To-Go package. They can be picked up in front of the Flagler Auditorium.

Brunch-To-Go packages will also be included with all sponsorship levels and will come with Ads placed in the souvenir booklet.

6. Our annual souvenir booklet will again be available this year for delivery prior to the event. Current T-shirts, hoodies, and past editions of our T-shirts will be available on our website at www.mlkcelebrationcommittee.com.

7. The "silent march" to the plaza this year will also be a little different from the past. Each person is encouraged to walk to the Plaza on their own and gather to say a prayer for Peace and Justice in the World (no march). Afterwards disperse for the day.
